Many of our members have expressed concern that the COVID-19 pandemic has prevented them from realizing the full benefits of their 2-year membership in New Villagers. We agree! As a result, the **NV Board has agreed to extend EVERY MEMBER'S graduation date** by a number of months that is equal to the number of months that the current health crisis continues to sideline our normal operations.
